Safety Rules and Emergency Plan Procedures



NOKC is committed to providing a safe environment for children to be able to develop their soccer skills and enhance their love of the sport.

Safety Rules

Goals

Do not climb, hang, or play on nets or goal post. Injuries relating to soccer goals relate mostly to portable goals, but there can also be injury in relation to permanent goals. Field and Goal Safety Inspections are done each season, Fall and Spring.

Driving

Please drive slowly in the complex. Players are often chasing balls and darting across the street. Make sure to always be checking your surroundings as there is high traffic at the complex.

Lightning Detector

The detector will give on alarm and the light on the top of the clubhouse will blink. This means clear the fields. Everyone (coaches, players, parents, siblings, etc.) needs to be in vehicles until an all clear sounds. An all clear will give 3 alarms and the light on top of the clubhouse will stop blinking, at that point you may go back on the field.

Background Screening

All coaches, volunteers, or others who interact with players (referees, managers, concession workers) all provide a background check through our governing body Oklahoma Soccer Association.

Club and Team Websites

We will not post pictures with players names, rosters, or addresses on our website or social media.

First Aid Kit

There is a First Aid Kit located in concession area at the club house.

Emergency Plan Procedures

Lost Child

In the event that there is a lost child the gate of the complex will be locked immediately and no one will be allowed to leave until the child is found. For assistance, reach out to any board member, adult referee, concession worker or any professional coach on site.

Injury

In case of injury please call 911 immediately. We will provide a trainer on site at our hosted tournaments, but for any league play or practices call 911.
